The books in the series include:

1. THE CATECHIST'S GUIDE TO READING YOUR BIBLE: A CATHOLIC VIEW (2014)

This book addresses many of the problems and concerns that catechists, parents and adult learners commonly face as they begin their journey of faith through Scripture. This guide is perfect for those who are new to Bible study as well as for those who want to increase their knowledge of the basics of what the Bible is and how to approach and study it.

2. WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM? THE CATECHIST'S GUIDE TO JESUS IN THE GOSPELS (2015)

This book situates Jesus in his first-century environment and considers the important relationships that reveal Jesus' identity as the human son of Mary and Joseph, the Israelite son of Abraham and son of David, the messianic son of Man and the unique son of God. Then it considers Jesus' public ministry: his goal of proclaiming God's forthcoming kingdom and the tasks, roles and strategies he adopted to achieve it, and finally the significance of his suffering, death and resurrection.

3. SO WHAT'S THE GOOD NEWS? THE CATECHIST'S GUIDE TO READING THE GOSPELS (2016)

This book provides some necessary background material to understand the historical situation in which the Gospels were composed, what the Gospels are and why they were written. The brief reading guide to each of the Gospels helps you to become familiar with that Gospel (including Luke's Acts of the Apostles, volume 2 of his Gospel.) and suggested resources offer ways to apply the Gospels to your life.

4. YOU'VE GOT MAIL! THE CATECHIST'S GUIDE TO READING THE NEW TESTAMENT LETTERS (2017)

This book offers the necessary background material about the early Christian urban social world and worldview to understand the historical situation in which the Letters were composed and what the authors, in particular Paul whom we know most about, were experiencing as they created and sustained their new Christian identity in a non-Christian world. There are also reading guides to each of the Letters, first those of Paul, then those of his followers and finally those of the other authors that will help you become familiar with each letter and discover what each offers us today.

5. REASSURING VISIONS: THE CATECHIST'S GUIDE TO READING JOHN'S BOOK OF REVELATION (2017)

This book focuses on the basic things that any reader needs to know about the *Book of Revelation's* author, audience, their situation, the book's form, content and function (properly understood in the way John intended). The reading guide helps understand the meaning of John's 4 magnificent reassuring visions of Christ in the Christian community, in the cosmos, in human history and in his final triumph over evil.
